Key Responsibilities

Program development and strategic planning:

- Conceive new program concepts and innovative learning formats across music genres and age groups.
- Evaluate activities and ensure the continuous improvement and expansion of the program.
- Oversee the communication strategy of the Discover pillar in collaboration with the Marketing team to ensure coherent narrative and key messages.

Project management and activities:

- Manage projects end-to-end: planning, logistics, technical and artistic production, budgets, administrative follow-up, lessons learned, reporting, etc.
- Coordinate all internal and external (artists, educators, partners, schools, etc.) stakeholders.
- Organise and supervise workshops, educational concerts, guided tours, talent programs, etc. in line with the Discover strategy.
- Welcome, supervise, accompany audiences, ensuring a high-quality participant experience.
- Propose, design and review educational materials.

Partnerships and collaboration:

- Build and maintain strong relationships with schools, cultural organisations, youth institutions, educators, artists and other collaborators.
- Recruit, brief and oversee coaches, artists, workshop leaders and contributors.
- Represent Rocklab in youth programming events.
